### Program wise Requirement of Teaching Posts for the Academic Year 2018-2019

The Vice-Chancellor explained to members of the Board of Governors that it has been decided to offer 46 programs in REVA University during the academic year 2018-2019. The number of teaching posts required for the academic year 2018-2019 has been calculated based on the intake of proposed programs and the number of students of earlier years on roll and the total number of posts required is 594. The program wise details of teaching faculty required is provided in the annexure below. The matter is placed before the august house with a request to consider and grant sanction for 594 teaching posts as detailed in the below given table, for the academic year 2018-2019.

#### Decision:

The members of the Board of Governors discussed in detail the program wise requirement of teaching posts and unanimously decided to sanction 594 teaching posts as detailed below for the academic year 2018-2019.
