MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered on 5th March 2018.

BETWEEN

Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India, having their registered office at P.O. Bhat 382428 Dist. Gandhinagar Gujarat, represented by its Director, hereinafter referred as EDII or the first party shall include all their representatives,

AND

REVA University Bangalore, Karnataka, India having their campus at Rukmini Knowledge Park, Yelahanka, Bengaluru, Karnataka, India, represented by its Chancellor hereinafter referred to as REVA University or Second Party and shall include all their representatives.

WHEREAS Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India (EDII), an autonomous body and not-for-profit institution, set up in 1983, is sponsored by apex financial institutions. namely the IDBI Bank Limited, the IFCI Limited, the ICICI Limited and State Bank of India (SBI), with support from the Government of Gujarat. The Institute is registered under the Societies Registration Act 1860 and the Public Trust Act 1950. The Government of Gujarat pledged twenty-three acres of land on which stands the majestic and sprawling EDII campus, having expressed interest, as Knowledge Partner, in association with REVA University in setting up School of Entrepreneurship and Family Enterprise (SEFE). Both the parties agree upon the scope, terms and conditions of their association as described hereunder:

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- EDII agrees to support REVA University, as Knowledge Partner, in designing and conducting certification programs, diploma programs in Entrepreneurship Development.
- As Knowledge Partner, the responsibilities of EDII include extending subject related professional advice and support to REVA University with no administrative, financial or statutory obligations which will be part of responsibilities of REVA University.
- 3. EDII agrees to support in conducting BBA (Entrepreneurship) and MBA (Entrepreneurship) programs with twinning option under which students will attend one semester at EDII Campus during the period of study. The degrees will be awarded as per the norms and standards of the University and in accordance with the regulatory provisions of UGC.
- EDII agrees to conduct Faculty Development Programmes to train faculty members of REVA University to conduct various programs jointly organized by EDII-REVA University.
- EDII agrees to support REVA University in organizing Entrepreneurship Development Programmes, Entrepreneurship Awareness Camps. National and International Seminars/Conferences.
- 6. EDII agrees to support REVA University in running Doctoral Program in Entrepreneurship Development area while Ph.D. degrees would be awarded by REVA University in accordance with the norms and standards of the University and as specified by UGC.
- REVA University would be required to provide necessary classroom facility and other physical infrastructure to conduct various programs.
- REVA University agrees to provide infrastructural facilities to EDII on a regular basis
 and review the same time-to-time to ensure smooth implementation of all the above
 mentioned programmes.
- REVA University will provide a Full Time Director with necessary qualifications and with a proven track record of experience in entrepreneurship development.
- 10. REVA University will promote the programs offered by the SEFE and will acknowledge the partnership with EDII prominently in all the promotional literature and material.
- 11. All the programs will be conducted after due approvals by REVA University Board of Studies and Academic Council.

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- 12. The syllabus structure, content, delivery and examination and evaluation for Programs and Courses will be as per the approved norms and standards from REVA University.
- 13. EDII will review and upgrade the curriculum from time to time, to meet the business / corporate/ industry needs in consultation with REVA University.

All policy matters including financial aspects like fee fixation, remuneration to EDII visiting faculty and fee sharing will be decided by a Joint Management Board represented by Director, EDII and his nominees and Vice Chancellor, Registrar and Director of the School.

The duration of the MOU is for a period of 2 years effective from the date of signing the MOU and will be renewed after periodic reviews on a mutually agreeable basis.

- Neither party shall be held responsible for non-fulfilment of their respective
 obligations under this agreement due to exigency of one or more of the force majeure
 events such as acts like floods, earthquake, strike, lockouts, epidemics, riots, wars
 and commotions etc., provided on the occurrence and cessation or cessation of such
 events, the party within one month of such occurrence or cessation.
- If the force majeure conditions continue beyond six months, the parties shall then
 mutually decide about the future course of action.

This agreement could be terminated by both the parties with a three months' notice but both parties to ensure that the on- going programmes shall be completed without any inconvenience to the University students.

Scope

This MOU is entered on the 23rd July 2018 between

Kigyan School of Data Science Pvt Ltd.

(Hereinafter referred to as Kigyan) a reputed Services Company Located at Jayanagar 9th Block, Bangalore, India.

And

REVA University

(Hereinafter referred to as Institution), a reputed College located in Bangalore.

The aforesaid organizations will be individually referred to as Party and jointly as parties.

Objectives of the MOU

The objectives of the MOU are

- a) To support the institute in following activities
 - i) To help the students to achieve their aspiration
 - To make the students aware of the latest technologies in the market
 - iii) Internship of the students
 - iv) Execution of Projects by the students
 - v) Skill development of the students in the latest Technologies
 - vi) Placement Assistance
- b) Collaborate with College on the Research Projects
- c) Training of Faculty in the latest Technologies

Technical Areas of Collaboration

- a) Provide academic interaction by delivering special lectures at Institution on topics of relevance to Modern Industry
- Organizing workshops and seminars to students and faculty to make them aware of the latest trends in Technologies
- c) Conducting Internships for the students and evaluation
- d) Execution of projects by the students
- e) Collaborating with the college for the research projects
- f) Training the faculty in the latest technologies





Proposed Modes of Collaboration

Kigyan and Institution propose to collaborate through the following:

- a) Conducting workshops on agreed topics
- b) Internship for the students on the latest emerging technologies for a period of 4 to 6 weeks as per industry practices
- Execution of the projects by the students under Virtual Corporate Program for a period from 4-6 months depending on the complexities of the project
- d) Training of the Faculty on agreed topics under Faculty Development Program(FDP)
- e) Any other appropriate mode of interaction agreed between Kigyan and Institution

A specific plan will be developed by both parties depending upon availability of resources.

Terms and Conditions

- a) The workshop, internship, VCP & FDP will be held at Institution and all basic infrastructures relating to the same as class rooms, audio video display systems with mikes, tables and chairs will be provided by Institution.
- All software & tools relating to the Technologies for the above will be provided by Kigyan.
- c) For the workshops, Internships, Virtual corporate program and Faculty Development Program a nominal fee will be charged to the students or college based on the number of students.
- d) The hardware and software for the projects under VCP will be provided by Kigyan but if the projects are to be submitted as final year projects by the students, the cost of the hardware and software will be borne by the students.
- e) This MOU may be amended, renewed, terminated by mutual written agreement of both the parties anytime.
- f) Either Party shall have the right to terminate this MOU upon sixty days prior notice to the other party.
- g) Kigyan will help in preparing the Students for recruitment by Private Companies provided they successfully clear the certification after the completion of the projects under VCP but in no case it takes guarantee of the same.
- Kigyan will also recruit the students provided they successfully clear the certification after the completion of the projects under VCP as per requirement.
- All payments to be made for different programs will be collected by the college designated representative and then paid to Kigyan.





Confidentiality

- a) Institution and Kigyan agree to hold in confidence all information / data designated by the institutes as confidential which is obtained from either institute or created during the performance of the MOU and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other institute
- b) The above confidential clause under this MOU excludes the information/data possessed by either institute before entering into this MOU or independently developed and / or information already available through public domain

Duration of MOU

This MOU, unless extended by mutual written consent of the institutes, shall expire in Two (2) years after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph, however, on review, the MOU shall be extended for another Two (2) years by mutual consent.

Coordinators

Both Institutes will designate persons who will have responsibility for co-ordination and implementation of the agreement.

Intellectual Property Rights

The Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) that arise as a result of joint collaboration activity under the agreement will be worked out on a case to case basis and will be consistent with officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutes.



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Interest of KMT is made on the Wenneson, 18th of July 2018 b, and between KPIT Technologies Limited hereinafter referred to as KPIT, having its Registrated office at Plot No. 35 & 36. Rajiv Gandhi Infotech Park, Phase 1, MIDC Hinjewadi Pune 411 057 and REVA University, located at Rukmini Knowledge Park, Kattigenahalli hereinafter referred to as "REVA University".

1. Introduction

KPIT is a global IT Consulting and Product Engineering partner focused on co-innovating domain intensive, technology solutions for corporations specializing in automotive & transportation, manufacturing and energy & utilities.

WHEREAS, REVA Group of Institutions is established by Rukmini Educational Charitable Trust (RECT), well-known in Technical, Science, Arts and Management programs since 2004 in Karnataka. The REVA University, Bengaluru is approved by **UGC** and Govt. of Karnataka. In REVA Group of Institutions REVA ITM is NBA accredited and REVA ISM is **NAAC** accredited with 'A' grade.

REVA University has been conferred as the "Most promising upcoming University" by BERG Singapore and Economic Times. The REVA University boasts state of the art infrastructure and the campus is one of the best in the country.

Whereas the parties have decided to enter into a strategic alliance on terms mutually beneficial to them as provided in this MoU.

2. Objectives of Cooperation

The main objective of this MoU is to initiate PACE (Program for Academic Collaboration and Engagement) and to provide a platform to build a strong and on-going relationship between KPIT and REVA University The primary goals of PACE are –

- To develop and foster strategic linkages between "REVA University" and the technical departments at KPIT
- To understand the needs and expectations of both the Institute and KPIT and to execute relevant identified activity required to meet the needs and expectations therein.
- Offering courses of mutual interest to the students and issuing the students certificates jointly, upon successful completion of the course.

- KPIT will permit their Engineers and Experts to tender their expertise for the benefit of the students when they are requested for specially focused programs.
- KPIT will sponsor/mentor UG / PG students' projects of mutual interest and convenience.
- KPIT will promote various activities for overall development of students of "REVA University"
- KPIT will advise for achieving programme educational objectives and outcomes of the UG programmes.
- Exploring and carrying out any other academic activity with mutual consent.
- 11. Provide exposure to students & faculty members to emerging technologies
- Help bridge the gap between academia and industry and contribute to the education eco system
- Participate in enhancing the knowledge of niche technologies and domain education by partnering with "REVA University"

3. Coordination

Under PACE, KPIT and REVA University shall establish a joint working group for coordination. Both parties shall ensure that the joint working group comprises of appropriate personnel to discuss and implement the activities mentioned in this MoU. From REVA University, it would be the Heads of the departments, PACE SPOC from the Institution, Head of Training and Placement division. From KPIT it would be, Head of Learning, SPOC for PACE programs, representatives from specific practices. Both parties (KPIT and REVA University) shall take all reasonable steps to cooperate and ensure successful implementation of all the measures mentioned in this MoU.

4. Mechanisms for Cooperation

The joint working group shall implement, administers and executes the following measures as under -

4.1 Integral Part of academic curriculum planning

KPIT shall participate in planning the academic curriculum by providing the field inputs, technology driven changes to the Board of Studies (BoS) at the departmental level or the Departmental Academic Committee (DAC). This BoS and DAC shall take all such inputs to the cluster level BoS of the institute and finalize the curriculum.

4.3 Projects for Under Graduates and Post Graduates

KPIT shall explore the possibility of increased student and faculty interface by offering projects for students of UG and PG programmes, depending on the need and availability of such projects at KPIT. Since such projects shall constitute a partial fulfillment for the award of the respective degrees, KPIT shall have to evaluate the projects carried out by the students as per the norms of the Institute/ University. Project Coordinators of REVA University shall extend all support to KPIT for the evaluation process.

4.4 Placement support to REVA University

PACE aims at identification of the right young people who will join KPIT in its quest for being practice leaders in the niche areas we are focused on. Hence, KPIT shall recruit competent and potential students of final year of UG/ PG programmes depending on their annual need and growth plan. This activity shall be governed by the selection process steered, jointly, by the Placement Cell, of REVA University and KPIT. KPIT is under no compulsion to guarantee Placements to the students of "REVA University".

4.5 Participation in technical events

As per the PACE program, KPIT shall consider participation in technical events. Events include National/International conferences, workshops, finishing schools, symposia, value-add courses hosted by REVA University. The final decision shall be taken on a case to case basis after review and discussion between the two parties.

4.6 Internships to students

In order to impart practical training under PACE, KPIT shall identify, encourage and support the evolving technical competence in students by providing paid internships to students during their vacation period between successive semesters depending on KPIT requirements. KPIT shall deploy such interns on specific technical works at their development centers. KPIT shall evaluate the quality of the work carried out by the interns and award them with a certificate at the end of the internships at KPIT's discretion on the basis of their performance. Industry-Institute Coordinator of REVA University shall co-ordinate with KPIT throughout the process including initiation of the internship request at the appropriate time, selection of students for the internship, overseeing the technical work carried out by the interns and the evaluation of the work carried out by the interns as might be required by KPIT.

6. Confidentiality

- 6.1 Either party may disclose its Confidential Information (as defined hereinafter) to the other party and the party disclosing the Confidential Information is referred as "Discloser" and the party receiving such information is referred as "Recipient".
- 6.2 Recipient shall keep the confidentiality of the Confidential Information of the Discloser and not use the Confidential Information for any purpose other than the purpose for which it the Confidential Information was provided to the Recipient.
- 6.3 Upon request by the Discloser, Recipient shall immediately return the Confidential Information of the Discloser.
- "Confidential Information" shall mean and include KPIT proprietary technologies, all information and trade secrets exchanged by the parties hereto, including without limitation, technical or non-technical data, processes, know-how, business plans, forecasts, ideas, concepts, non-public financial plans and financial data, information about KPIT's clients and vendors and all other information, whether as a whole or any part thereof, that a reasonable person would deem confidential.
- 6.5 Confidential Information shall not include information which: (a) is or becomes a part of the public domain through no act or omission of the Recipient; (b) can be shown to be already possessed by the Recipient as of the date of disclosure; (c) is made available to the Recipient on a non-confidential basis by a third party having a right to do so; or (d) is disclosed by order of a court of competent jurisdiction.
- 6.6 The obligation to maintain confidentiality shall survive this Agreement for a period of two (2) years from the date of disclosure.
- 6.7 REVA University shall cooperate with KPIT in getting Non-Disclosure Agreements signed by the students if such request is made by KPIT.

Selection process

The entire recruitment procedure shall be decided by the KPIT Campus Recruitment Team which shall decide the procedure of campus recruitment including but not limited to selection criteria, selection process and elimination rounds.

The 'Project' here is the "Qualification Pack (QP) based training programs" developed with an objective of scaling quality capacity.

NASSCOM / SSC NASSCOM and REVA can herein be referred to independently as 'First Party', and 'Second Party' respectively and collectively referred to as 'Parties'.

THE MoU WITNESSED AND THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Objective of the MoU

- (a) Increase the employability of students in the **REVA** and colleges, under the aegis of the **REVA** by facilitating the development and introduction of the QP-based training programs
- (b) Help facilitate a sustainable Faculty Development Program
- (c) Facilitate teaching-learning support for pursuance of the said course/s to enhance student employability
- (d) Recommend relevant courseware, certain books, e-tools, e-content and websites to support the self-paced learning for students
- (e) Introduce the skill assessment/metric for QP-based assessments for students at the entry level, in conjunction with the programs, to analyse the efficacy of the multiple skill development programs
- (f) Introduce the skill assessment/metric for QP-based assessments for students, to facilitate employment at the entry level
- (g) Facilitate students towards QP certification via these newly introduced course/s during the UG program and appear for the QP assessment at the appropriate NSQF level (National Skills Qualification Framework)

2. Period of MoU

- IP of the courseware/s and OBF curriculum/la developed shall lie with NASSCOM/ SSC NASSCOM
- iv. Train at cost, select faculty from identified colleges (nominated by REVA who would participate in the development of QP-based programs) and from identified Third Party Training Providers, as nominated jointly by REVA as one batch [of 25 per QP (Qualification Pack)], as 'Master Faculty/Trainers'
- (d) The modus operandus of Master Faculty training is to be detailed and directed consultatively by REVA and NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM
- (e) Facilitate a consultative approach by helping REVA set up a "WORKING GROUP" to identify Third Party Training Providers, if required. This group will also be empowered to take decisions on modalities/logistics for the smooth roll out of the program.
- (f) Provide the necessary guidelines for a skill development cycle and the information w.r.t. infrastructure requirements for the program regarding the QP concerned, as indicated in the Outcomes Based Framework for the same.
- (g) The Outcomes Based Framework for each of the QPs and the Certification for the same will be provided/facilitated by NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM @INR 5000/- exclusive of taxes (per QP) for the REVA. REVA may choose to use the curricula of the QP concerned in the OBF format, or go in for the Curriculum Alignment for the same as per their own requirement, at cost (@INR 5000/- exclusive of taxes per QP). Taxes as applicable will paid by the Parties concerned.
- (h) Post the conduct of training, facilitate assessments of candidates/students on QPs at cost (presently at INR 1,000/- per student per test, exclusive of taxes), via identified assessment providers of NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM. Taxes as applicable will paid by REVA
- QP based assessment for faculty w.r.t. TVET QPs (ie Teaching Pedagogy) is presently applicable at INR 1200/- per assessment, exclusive of taxes. All applicable taxes have to be addressed by REVA
- (j) Maintain a centralised employment portal which is aimed to facilitate the employability of students that are trained and assessed using QP-based assessments
- (k) Provide an analysis of student performance on the basis of the scores attained. NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM and REVA jointly own the database of trained resources through, which would be shared with all NASSCOM members (including the ones who have provided their concurrence towards recognizing the program). Intent would be to increase the scope of employment opportunities.
- (I) Facilitate the development of courseware guides/hand books for teachers and students respectively for the designed QP curriculum for Phase I QPs identified

4. Responsibility of the REVA

- (a) Select the list of QPs, basis feedback from NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM for which training programs will be developed and deployed for students
- (b) Avail the courseware at cost for the identified QP from NASSCOM /SSC NASSCOM
- (c) Post availing the content, select colleges for Phase i of this project.
- (d) Select faculty from the identified colleges (REVA to screen such faculty based on certain selection parameters prescribed by NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM), who will be trained in the

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- programs along with the faculty from the Third Party Training Provider, so that they can handhold students during the Phase I
- (e) Identify the requisite number students from the REVA / colleges identified to undergo the training program and assessments
- (f) Facilitate QP-based assessments, at cost, for the target student audience w.r.t. the REVA
- (g) Select Third Party Training Providers, for the programs as per selection criteria and process defined by NASSCOM/ SSC NASSCOM, if required
- (h) Organise the logistics and facilitate the Industry Trainers program for the programs towards:
 - a. Faculty development
 - b. Student training

This will also include boarding & lodging, local travel for Industry Trainers for the programs.

- (i) Organise the logistics and facilitate the Third Party Training Providers for the programs towards:
 - a. Faculty development
 - Student training

This will also include boarding and lodging, local travel for such Trainers for the programs.

- (j) NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM and REVA to jointly own up database of trained resources, which would be shared with all NASSCOM members (including the ones who have provided their concurrence towards recognizing the program), intent would be to increase the scope of employment opportunities
- (k) REVA to bear the cost of conducting the Master Trainer program, including the cost of Industry Trainers as indicated below in the Clause 'Funding'
- (I) REVA to conduct TTT and the subsequent student training at its own cost
- (m) For the conduct of QP based assessments REVA shall make 100% advance payment of assessment cost to NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM i.e. the First Party for all the batches for which the First Party shall have given acceptance against requisition and the First Party hall give an acknowledgement of advance payment.

- (d) **REVA** to provide any other assistance as may be required from time to time to further the promotion or the management of the programs concerned

9. Intellectual Proprietary rights in SSC NASSCOM / NASSCOM material

- (a) The proprietary rights in relation to the material provided to REVA and its affiliated institutions w.r.t. QPs shall rest with NASSCOM /SSC NASSCOM; REVA shall have the right to use the curricula and course material in accordance to the terms of this MoU.
- (b) NASSCOM/ SSC NASSCOM is the owner of all the intellectual proprietary rights with regard to the training material thus developed (teacher and the taught), and neither this MoU nor the training material shall directly or indirectly create for REVA or colleges under its aegis any right, title or interest therein
- (c) REVA acknowledges and agrees that NASSCOM /SSC NASSCOM owns all rights, title/s and interest in NASSCOM /SSC NASSCOM training material/s, including, without limitation, all intellectual property rights and goodwill therein. REVA will not delete or after in any manner the copyright, trademark and other proprietary rights, notices etc. appearing in the training material provided by NASSCOM/ SSC NASSCOM

10. Indemnity

REVA also hereby agrees to indemnify and hold NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM harmless from any loss, claim, damage, costs, taxes, duties, additions, penalties, interest thereon or expenses of any kind, including the attorney's fees if any, to which NASSCOM /SSC NASSCOM may be subjected to by virtue of any finding related to the terms of the MoU or by virtue of any contravention and or non-compliance on the part of REVA and its affiliated colleges—and vice-versa with any laws, ordinance, regulations and codes as may be applicable from time to time.

11. Jurisdiction and Arbitration

In the event of any or difference between the Parties hereto, the courts in Delhi alone shall have exclusive jurisdiction to try any matter arising between the Parties here-to and accordingly both the Parties shall submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts in Delhi as mutually decided at that time for this purpose.

13. Amendment of the MoU

Such changes will be formalized in writing as an 'Addendum' to this MoU and will be deemed to be a part of this MoU.

14. Force Majeure

- (b) For purposes of this Clause, "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of Parties and not involving Parties and not involving fault or negligence not foreseeable by or beyond the

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control of Parties. Events also include wars or rebellion, strikes, bandhs, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions and freight embargoes etc.

(c) If a Force Majeure situation arises, either Party shall promptly notify the other in writing of such conditions and the cause thereof. Unless otherwise directed by either the REVA or NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM, in writing, both Parties shall continue to perform their independent obligations under this MOU as far as reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event. REVA or NASSCOM/SSC NASSCOM can opt out of this MoU on mutually agreeable terms and conditions in writing, as the case may be, prompted by a Force Majeure.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") is made on 25th May, 2017

Between

REVA University, having its registered Office at Rukmini Knowledge Park, Kattigenahalli, Yelahanka, Bengaluru, Karnataka 560064, holding PAN No. AABTR 1107Q (hereinafter referred to as the "First Party" which expression, where the context so admits, be deemed to include its successors and assigns) of the First Party.

And

Hexis Hiring Pvt. Ltd., having its registered office at Ground floor, B Block, NR Enclave, Bengaluru - 53, holding the PAN No. AAECH1106K (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party" which expression, where the context so admits, be deemed to include its successors and assigns) on the Second Party.

Whereas, the First Party is a well-established University in Bengaluru and is engaged in providing Graduate, Post Graduate, Doctoral degree programs and other education programs / courses approved by the University Grant Commission. It produces Graduates, Post Graduates and Doctorates every year, who, after completion of their respective programs, serve in different sectors of the society, such as industries, Corporates, academic institutions, Government Departments, Business Organizations, R&D Institutions etc.

AND WHEREAS, the Second Party offers a unique placement platform, which, through its medium provides training to candidates, making them capable of securing employment with large multinational companies in India.

Both the parties are desirous of collaborating to impart training to undergraduate and post graduate students under the aegis of the First Party, with the intention to offer them for employment to various real estate and facility management companies as fresh trainees in the Facility Management Service sector.

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AND WHEREAS the Parties hereto are desirous of recording the terms and conditions of their agreement in writing.

NOW THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSETH AS UNDER:

Both the parties agreed to collaborate and offer a Foundation Course in Facility Management to facilitate candidates better employment opportunities in Real Estate and Facility Management Service sector and the parties agree to share the responsibility together.

Foundation Course in Facility Management

Foundation Course in Facility Management is designed to meet the huge requirement of infrastructure industry with expertise in supervising and managing the staff of the maintenance of buildings, complexes and such other infrastructure. The course provides all the necessary knowledge and skill required for supervision and maintenance of infrastructure facility including large Corporates.

Eligibility for Admissions to the Course

This certificate course is meant for the under graduates and post graduates with Pass percentage of marks. However, the course shall also be extended to ongoing students studying under graduate and post graduate programs, as a certificate course.

Duration of the Program

The duration of Foundation Course in Facility Management is for a period of 4 months.

OBLIGATIONS OF REVA UNIVERSITY

REVA University shall:

- 1. Set the Regulations / Guidelines for introduction of the course
- Constitute an Expert Committee comprising of experts from industries and academia specialized in the area of facility management and convene timely meetings to ensure the program quality. The committee shall design course curriculum, contents, delivery, and recommend on fee structure and other requirements of the course.

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- Scrutinize and approve the list of candidates admitted for the course in accordance with the prescribed qualifications.
- 4. Provide academic support in delivering the course.
- Monitor the conduct of the program and students' performance to maintain the quality of imparting the course.
- 6. Arrange for conduct of examinations, evaluation and declare the results.
- Issue the certificate to the candidates who have the satisfactory performance in the assessment and examination.
- Take necessary steps to update the curriculum and syllabus to meet the marketing requirement from time to time.

OBLIGATIONS OF HEXIS HIRING PVT. LTD, BENGALURU

Hexis Hiring Pvt. Ltd, Bengaluru shall:

- Support University in developing career enhancing program(s) and contents in facility management in consultation with academicians, industry experts and recruiters.
- 2. Provide the necessary administration controls to the learning management portal to monitor the program regularly.
- Create course delivery modules based on the curriculum and content designed by the Expert Committee.
- 4. Promote the programs through various channels and platforms and ensure the number of enrollments.
- Enroll the students to the course as per the prescribed qualifications and submit the list of candidates admitted to the course and obtain approval from the University.
- 6. Create infrastructure to impart the program and maintain the quality of high order.
- Arrange for delivering the course by adopting hybrid mode of teaching and learning and making them employment ready.
- 8. Empanel a set of trainers and evaluators and monitor their performance.
- Monitor the progress of candidates in learning and supporting with their queries and other requirements
- 10. Extend support to the University in conduct of examinations and evaluation of the student's performance as per the set regulations / guidelines.
- Arrange for the placement of candidates who have successfully completed the course.

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 Constantly strive to improve the overall process and outcome of learning to better employment opportunities.

COMMERCIALS:

- The first party shall collect the fee as agreed by both the parties from time to time.
- 2. The second party shall pay the first party the following costs:
 - a. 20% of the fees collected from the students for each course soon after the enrolment of the students for a given batch is completed.
 - b. One-time fee of Rs. 3.00 lakhs towards affiliation cost, processing cost and program monitoring cost.

The above obligations / terms and conditions including commercials shall be reviewed periodically from time to time.

GENERAL:

This program is intended to work together in collaboration and train candidates and facilitate them placements in Real Estate and Facility Management Sector. Further, both the parties agree that this course is exclusively offered by REVA University only and the second party will not enter into MoU with any other Institutions / University to offer this course. However, it is not intended to create a relationship such as a partnership, franchise, joint venture, or agency.

Neither Party herein shall act in a manner that expresses or implies a relationship other than that of independent Parties nor bind the other parties.

This MoU contains the entire understanding between the Parties relating to the subject matter hereof and same as may be expressly referred to or referenced herein, supersedes all prior representations, writings, negotiations or understandings with respect hereto.

Any amendments, alterations or modifications to this MoU shall be mutually agreed between the Parties in writing only.

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TERMINATION OF THE CONTRACT:

This MoU will take effect from the date of its signing. It shall be valid for a period of 12 months from date of signing and it may be renewed further period upon mutual consent of both the parties in writing.

Either party may terminate the MoU after giving written notice to the other party 90 days in advance. Once terminated, neither REVA University nor Hexis Hiring Pvt. Ltd will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other party may suffer. However, REVA University and Hexis Hiring Pvt. Ltd shall be responsible for conduct of academic and examination related activities of the students already admitted to the course until they complete their course successfully.
